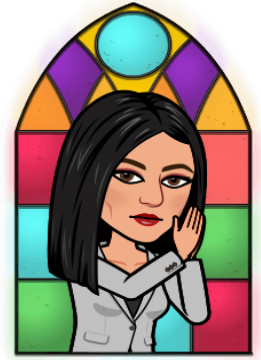


RE Summer Art Competition



Dear Families,

We have an exciting, RE themed art competition for your child to take part in over the summer break. We are creating a prayer area in our playground where the children can sit and either pray or be reflective. We would like the children to design a symbol for their class value. There will be a winning entry from each class and that design will be painted onto Perspex to create a stained glass image which will form windows in one of our wooden, tee pee huts in the playground. The huts are shaped to allow for 7 windows, one for each class's value. The symbol needs to be quite plain but effective as intricate detail will not be achieved on the Perspex. The values were chosen by the children themselves based on what they felt were the most significant of the school's existing 12 values and are the ones they felt were important to make their school a safe a caring place to learn and flourish. The values chosen are:

Reception = Friendship

Year 1 = Thankfulness

Year 2 = Trust

Year 3 = Justice

Year 4 = Service

Year 5 = Forgiveness

Year 6 = Compassion



Please ask you child not to include any words or lettering on their design as it is purely just the symbol that we need. All designs can be submitted on a plain piece of A4 paper and will be collected in by your child's class teacher on Friday 18th September. The winning entries from each class will be announced the following week in Celebration Assembly.
