Curriculum Map

Subject	What will we be focussing on?
Maths	We are starting off with a recap of fractions . This can be tricky, so we are revisiting to ensure we have all got a strong grasp of fractions before moving to year 5.
English	We are starting by writing a Tale of Fear . Later in the half term we will look at Diary writing.
Science	This half term we are looking at electricity . This will include looking at how it works as well as lots of different hands-on lessons to explore how circuits work.
History	We will be learning about Henry VIII and his Wives this half term. Which the children already seem to be very excited about!
Art	Our art will be based on Tudor portraits, but we will be putting a twist on them, and also looking at Collage .
Computing	We are exploring animation this half term.
PE	We will be doing cricket on a Monday, and athletics on Tuesdays.
RE	The class will be learning about Sikhism. They will explore the question: How do Sikhs put their beliefs about equality into practice?
Music	The children will continue with the theme from last term.
PSHE	The children will be learning about Changing Me . Looking into how bodies change as we get older.
French	The children will continue to practice and learn more of the French language.
