Curriculum Map: Autumn 1



What are we learning this half term?

English	We will be writing journey stories and persuasive letters . We will also be revising our Year 1 phonics sounds, learning the past tense in Year 2 grammar, and working on reading skills including vocabulary, inference and sequencing. Our first class book will be 'The Climbers' by Ali Standish.
Maths	We will be focusing on key number and place value concepts, before moving on to addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers. Our 'Big Maths' will build our confidence with number bonds to 10 and 20.
Science	Our topic is ' Animals including Humans ', where we will be learning about life cycles and how to keep healthy.
Geography	We will be comparing Eye and China , focusing on human and physical geography, landmarks, and vocabulary such as town, country and continent.
PE	We are building on our fundamental skills (including balancing, jumping, running and throwing), as well as developing practical skills in Forest School .
RE	Our question to investigate is "Why do Jewish families talk about repentance at New Year?"
PSHE	Our unit title is " Being Me in My World ", where we will be discussing identity and emotions.
Art	We will be practising different methods of printing this half term.
Computing	Linking with our Art topic, we will be using PurpleMash software to learn methods of digital printing inspired by Mondrian and pointillism.
Music	We will learn about world music to think about the question 'How does music help us to make friends and connect with others?".
