Your child should be bringing in their reading record everyday.

Times Table tests will still continue every FRIDAY. Your child should be practicing their spellings **everyday**, this can be as simple as singing them on the way home from school, in the bath/shower, just before bed, or by using Times Table Rockstars. Curriculum Map

Here are the topics we will be covering this half term.

Subject	Topic
Maths	In Maths we are continuing with Multiplication and Division . Later in the half term we will be looking at Area and also starting our Fractions topic. NSPCC Number day is also this half term, stay tuned for more information on this!
English	We are starting the term with a Warning Tales , which will be taught alongside our class book 'Who Let the Gods Out?' by Maz Evans. We will also be exploring Poetry at the end of this half term.
Science	Our topic this half term is Electricity . We have already started looking at this and the children really enjoyed our first lesson.
Humanities	We are sticking with History this half term, and will be learning all about the Romans . This is a particular favourite of mine and I'm sure the children will also really enjoy!
PE	As mentioned above we will be going Swimming on Mondays this half term, they will also be doing Dance on a Thursday with Mrs Shadbolt.
Computing	In Computing we will be continuing to improve our touch typing skills , as well as learning how to use Spreadsheets .
PSHE	This half term our topic Dreams and Goals . This will explore the emotions involved with making goals, both short and long term and how we can overcome difficult times.
RE	We will be learning about Hinduism through the question 'How does the story of Rama and Sita inspire Hindus to follow their dharma?'
French	Our French topic this half term is La Famille, we will therefore be practicing our use of the French language through discussion about our families. As well as this, we will explore our Language of the Term, which is German.
Music	This half term we will be exploring 'Developing Pulse & Groove Through Improvisation'.
DT	This half term we will be designing and making torches ! This will be happening in the last week of this half term and ties in really nicely with our Science topic.
