Find here selections of books which our children will encounter during their guided reading sessions at St. Peter and St. Paul Primary School.

These texts are often a little above the level at which a child would read independently and are selected as they provide lots of basis for discussion (adult-led). Guided reading sessions aim to help children gain skills in comprehension and confidence in discussing a text. We also use techniques to improve fluency, but ultimately aim to foster an innate love of reading which stays with our young readers for life.

Our selection of books ensures that our children are given the opportunity to discover a broad range of authors, different structures of texts and a wide range of themes.

Children often read the whole text and therefore leave at the end of Year 6 having read a diverse range of high quality books and being familiar with a wide range of authors and illustrators.
