

Reception Oak Class Spring Term 2nd Half- People Who Help Us

Communication and Language

We will talk about the different 'People Who Help Us', listen to members of school staff and people in the community who help us and find out information from non-fiction books. We will focus on learning new vocabulary related to the topic.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This half term, we will talk about and practise food hygiene when cooking and talk about ways to keep healthy. We shall practise road safety on our walk around Eye and continue to build relationships in the role play areas.

Physical Development

In gymnastics, we will explore basic movements, creating shapes, balances, jumps and begin to develop rocking and rolling. We will copy, create, remember and repeat short sequences. We will also continue to develop our fine motor skills.

Literacy

We will continue to have daily phonics as well as read regularly each week. We shall practise using our phonic knowledge by writing in a variety of forms: a 'thank you' letter, non-fiction sentences, a recount and a list.

Mathematics

The focus will be on comparing lengths and heights as well as exploring time. We will practise representing 9 and 10 in different ways and explore their composition, before moving on to building and exploring numbers beyond 10.

Understanding the World

We will talk about our families and members of the school community, as well as listen to visitors who come into school. We will go on a walk around Eye.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will explore a variety of tools and techniques to practise drawing, painting, creating 3D models and exploring clay
